Goal 1:

More than 80% families have decent houses with sanitation and clean drinking water facilities.

1. Several poor people are helped by St Vincent De Paul Society, Catholic Sabha and the Diocese of Udupi.

Objective 2:

Women are elected and selected to take up the Parish Administration, to work in different Parish units and to get actively involved in the Pastoral Plan 'Mission 2025'.

Other Activities:

- 1. On 19th and 20th May there was an interactive session and training of the lay leaders in which 75 persons were present.
- 2. On 24th June nearly 600 lay leaders from different walks of life assembled together to promote Christian unity.
