Dear Rev. Fathers, Brothers and Sisters,

1. SEASON OF ADVENT

On Sunday, 01 December 2019, the Catholic Church all over the world begins the holy season of Advent which will conclude in the joyful celebration of the Solemnity of the birth of our Lord. The emphasis of this season remains on the coming of our Lord. The Catechism of the Catholic Church stresses the two-fold meaning of this coming: "When the Church celebrates the liturgy of Advent each year, she makes present this ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior's first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for his second coming. By celebrating the precursor's birth and martyrdom, the Church unites herself to his desire: "He must increase, but I must decrease" (CCC, 524).

I earnestly appeal to you, dear Fathers, to make this holy season of Advent a period of grace and blessings to your parishioners by inviting each of them to reflect on the beauty of Advent and prepare themselves, through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, to experience the peace and joy of the Divine Babe of Bethlehem.

2. THE FEAST OF HOLY FAMILY – FAMILY DAY

The feast of the Holy Family this year will be celebrated on Sunday, 29 December 2019. The Feast of the Holy Family is a liturgical celebration in honor of Jesus, Mary and Joseph as a family. The primary purpose of this feast is to present the Holy Family as a model for Christian families. Christ Himself showed His devotion to His mother and foster father by submitting Himself, with infinite humility, to the duty of filial obedience towards them. Pope Francis says: "Every family should look to the icon of the Holy Family of Nazareth. Its daily life had its share of burdens and even nightmares, as when they met with Herod's implacable violence. This last was an experience that, sad to say, continues to afflict the many refugee families who, in our day, feel rejected and helpless. Like the Magi, our families are invited to contemplate the Child and his Mother, to bow down and worship him" (AL 30). He invites us to celebrate this feast as the **Day of Families**. Therefore, I exhort all parish priests to celebrate the feast emphasizing the role of families in the Church.

3. ORDERS FOR THE NEW KONKANI MISSAL-REMINDER

In the last issue of *Vox Nostra* I had asked to place your orders for New Konkani Missal and related books before 20 November 2019. I am informed that some parishes and convents have not yet placed their orders with Divya Jyothi. I wish that every parish possesses two copies and the convents possess at least one copy of this new Konkani Missal. Hence, I request you to place your orders before 10

December 2019. The orders placed after that date will not be entertained and the pre-publication prices won't be applied to when you order in the future.

HOUSES FOR THE POOR PROJECT – YEAR 2020

As you are aware, Pope Francis often speaks about a Church that is in service of the poor, and in order to bring awareness among the faithful about this cause, he established the World Day of Poor on the penultimate Sunday of the Liturgical Year. We have celebrated the third World Day of Poor last month. "The poor are the Church's treasure because they give every Christian a chance to "speak the same language as Jesus, that of love," Pope Francis said, celebrating Mass for the World Day of the Poor 2019. "The poor are precious in the eyes of God," he said, "because they know they are not self-sufficient and know they need help. They remind us that that's how you live the Gospel, like beggars before God." "So," the Pope said, "instead of being annoyed when they knock on our doors, we can welcome their cry for help as a call to go out of ourselves, to welcome them with the same loving gaze God has for them."

Heeding the call of Pope Francis, to facilitate concrete action in serving the poor, we have decided to construct houses for the faithful of our Diocese who have their own land, but do not have a proper house to live in. This would be the focus in the year 2020 and each parish, under the leadership of Society of St Vincent De Paul in association with Sampada, shall prepare the project as per the need of the parish, mobilize the funds and implement the project

during the year. Please inform this to your parishioners and ask them to cooperate with the Society of St Vincent De Paul and Sampada in this noble cause of constructing houses for the poor.
