

Dear Rev. Fathers, Deacons, Brothers and Sisters,

1. DAY OF CONSECRATED LIFE

We celebrate the solemnity of the Presentation of the Lord on Sunday, **02 February 2025.** This celebration commemorates the presentation of Jesus by the Blessed Virgin Mary, His mother, to the Lord in the temple. On this day, the faithful go forth to meet the Lord as he comes, acclaiming him as did Simeon, who recognised in Christ the "Light to enlighten the nations." For the commemoration of the mystery of the day, the Missal foresees the blessing of candles with a procession or with a solemn entry, holding lighted candles in hands, proclaiming Christ as the light of the world.

The Church invites us to celebrate this day as the Day of the Consecrated Life. "The life consecrated through the profession of the evangelical counsels is a stable form of living by which the faithful, following Christ more closely under the action of the Holy Spirit, are totally dedicated to God who is loved most of all, so that, having been dedicated by a new and special title to His honour, to the building up of the Church, and to the salvation of the world, they strive for the perfection of charity in the service of the kingdom of God and, having been made an outstanding sign in the Church, foretell the heavenly glory" (can. 573 §1). As part of Jubilee 2025, it's a day dedicated to the **Jubilee of** Consecrated Life. I request you, dear parish priests, to apprise your faithful of the significance of the Consecrated Life in the Church and pray for all men and women in Consecrated Life during the holy Eucharist. On my behalf, I express my gratitude and appreciation to all Men and Women in Consecrated Life who are rendering their dedicated service in the Diocese of Udupi as per their charisms, contributing thereby to the growth of our local Church.

2. MISSIONARY HOLY CHILDHOOD DAY

The second Sunday of February, this year the 9th, is celebrated as the Missionary Holy Childhood Day. The aims of the Missionary Childhood Association are: 1. To meet the spiritual and material needs of all children so that they can live worthily as true children of God. 2. To sensitize children regarding the needs of others by teaching them the value of solidarity and mutual support. 3. To instil a missionary spirit in children that will accompany them throughout their lives, regardless of whether God will guide them towards lay or religious lives, making them valid and responsible members of society. I exhort all parish priests to celebrate this day meaningfully by organising activities and celebrations that will suit their age and enthusiasm and help them contribute in their own tiny way to the mission of the Church.

3. WORLD DAY OF THE SICK

February 11 is the 33rd World Day of the Sick, an observation started by Pope St John Paul II as a way for believers to offer prayers for those suffering from illnesses. The day coincides with the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes. As part of Jubilee 2025, it is a day dedicated to the sick. During this jubilee, let us pray for all the sick in our parishes. Let us offer them the closeness of the Church in their sickness and suffering through visiting them in hospitals and homes, and provide them with spiritual care, especially the sacrament of reconciliation and the Holy Communion.

4. ANNUAL FEAST OF ST LAWRENCE BASILICA-THANKS

The five days of solemn festivities of St Lawrence Basilica which began on 26 January 2025 were concluded on 30 January 2025 with great joy and gratitude, thanks to the continuous protection of St Lawrence, the wonder-worker. While the five days' celebrations were meticulously planned by the Shrine Basilica Management Committee, the flow of devotees and pilgrims was so peaceful, devotional, and reverential that year after year we see the wonders of St Lawrence in Attur in attracting pilgrims from far and wide.

A word of gratitude to Msgr. Ferdinand Gonsalves, our Vicar General, for being present at the Basilica for five days and for overseeing all the arrangements and celebrations.
