We celebrate the memorial of Our Lady of Mount Carmel on 16 July 2022. Mary, the Mother of God, has a multitude of titles under which she is invoked for various needs. Since the 15th century, popular devotion to Our Lady of Mount Carmel has been centred on the Scapular of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, also known as the Brown Scapular, a sacramental associated with the promise of Mother Mary's special aid for the salvation of the devoted wearer. The scapular stands for a commitment to follow Jesus, like Mary, the perfect model of all the disciples of Christ. It is also an expression of the belief that the bearers of the scapular will meet God in eternal life, aided by the intercession and prayers of Mary, our heavenly Mother. Let us invoke the maternal help of Our Lady of Mount Carmel as we celebrate her memorial.

3. WORLD DAY FOR GRAND-PARENTS AND THEELDERLY

The second world day for grandparents and the elderly, established by Pope Francis, will be celebrated on **Sunday**, **24 July 2022**. The pope has chosen the theme for this year: "They shall bear fruit even in old age" (Psalms 92:15). The theme intends to emphasize how grandparents and the elderly are a value and a gift to the society as well as ecclesial communities. It also invites us to reconsider and value grandparents and the elderly who are often kept on the margins of families, civil and ecclesial communities. Their experience of life and faith can contribute, in fact, to building societies that are aware of their roots and capable of dreaming of a future based on greater solidarity. Let us celebrate the day meaningfully in our parishes, highlighting the importance of grandparents and the elderly in families.

4. NEW DEAN FOR SHIRVA DEANERY

V. Rev. Fr Leslie D'Souza has been appointed as the new Dean of Shirva Deanery with effect from 08 June 2022. I convey my best wishes to V. Rev. 5. NEWAPOSTOLIC LETTER ON LITURGY

1. Pope Francis published a new apostolic letter titled 'Desiderio Desideravi' (I have earnestly desired) on 29 June 2022, on the liturgical formation of the people of God. The pope invites "the whole Church to rediscover, to safeguard, and to live the truth and power of the Christian celebration." Let us all read this letter, note its contents and always make an earnest atempt to celebrate the liturgy as a true encounter with the Lord. NEW CARDINALS FROM INDIA

Pope Francis announced, on 29 May 2022, that Abp. Filipe Neri Ferrão (69), Metropolitan Archbishop of Goa and Daman and the President of the CCBI and Patriarch "ad honorem" of the East Indies, and Abp. Anthony Poola (60) of Hyderabad will be elevated as Cardinals at a Consistory on Saturday, 27 August 2022.

Archbishop Filipe Neri António Sebastião do Rosário Ferrão was born on 20 January 1953, in Aldona in Goa. He was ordained priest on 28 October 1979, appointed Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Goa and Daman on 20 December, 1993, ordained Bishop on 10 April 1994 and assigned the titular see Vanariona. He was appointed the Metropolitan Archbishop of Goa and Damão and the Patriarch "ad honorem" of the East Indies on 12 December, 2003. He was installed as the Archbishop on 21 March, 2004. He was elected as the President of the CCBI at its 31st Plenary Assembly held in 2019 at Chennai. He was the former Chairman of the Federation of Asian Bishops' Conference's (FABC) Office of Education and Faith Formation (OEFF).

Archbishop Anthony Poola was born on 15 November, 1961, at

Chindhukur, Andhra Pradesh. He was ordained priest on 20 February, 1992. He was appointed as the Bishop of Kurnool on 8 February, 2008 and ordained Bishop on 19 April 2008. He was appointed as the Archbishop of Hyderabad by Pope Francis on 19 November, 2020. He was installed as the eleventh Archbishop on 3 January, 2021.

We rejoice at this good news to the Indian Church of the elevation of two Indian Bishops as Cardinals, and we offer our hearty congratulations and best wishes to them as they are being elevated as Cardinals in the consistory on 27 August 2022 in the Vatican.
