Additionally, as we are in the process of revising the statutes of participatory structures such as the Parish Pastoral Council (PPC), Parish Finance Council (PFC), etc., the Deans are requested to collect and submit any suggestions for revision by the same date — 15 July 2025.

11. NEW EPISCOPAL VICAR FOR RELIGIOUS

Rev. Fr. Joe Tauro, OCD, has been appointed as the Episcopal Vicar for Religious in the Diocese of Udupi w.e.f. 01 July 2025. Fr Joe Tauro, known for his dedicated priestly service and close collaboration with various religious communities, will now take on this important role and will serve as a bridge and support for all religious men and women in the Diocese, helping to promote greater unity, mutual understanding, and shared mission. I invite all Religious working in the Diocese to extend their wholehearted cooperation to him as he takes up this responsibility in the service of the Church.
