1 FEAST OF ST JOSEPH THE WORKER AND INTERNATIONAL WORKERS' DAY

The feast of St Joseph the Worker and International Workers' Day, also known as Labour Day/May Day, is celebrated all over the world on May 1. May Day gives us the beautiful remembrance of the events and endeavours contributed to the solidarity of workers, dignity of labour and prosperity, unity and harmony, the workers endeared through their sweat and toil. It is eminently fitting that St Joseph, a worker who became the foster father of Jesus is the patron of the universal Church. The feast of St Joseph the Worker was established by Pope Pius XII in 1955 in order to Christianize the concept of Labour and give to all workmen a model and a protector. The theme for May Day 2017 given by CBCI commission for Labour is 'Migration and Human Trafficking': "I was a stranger and you welcomed me." (Mt 25:35) It invites us to reflect on the problem of migration and human trafficking which are interlinked, where unorganized workers and uninformed persons leave their homes for work or brought for work. The Commission for Labour in our diocese works towards the organization of the unorganised labourers to avail their rights. Let us support its activities and promote the welfare of all workers, without any discrimination.

2 MAY DEVOTION TO THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

The *May Devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary* refers to the special Marian devotion held in the Catholic Church during the month of May honouring Mother Mary as the 'Queen of May'. Catholics

offer special honour to Mother Mary in May: pilgrimages, visits to Marian churches, little sacrifices in her honour, and a more attentive recitation of the Rosary. We have a beautiful tradition of reciting Marian Rosary around the Grotto of our Lady in our parishes. Hence I hereby exhort you, dear Fathers, to continue to uphold this tradition by inviting your parishioners to gather around the Grotto for the Rosary. The month of May is also an occasion for us to catechize our faithful on the devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary in the Catholic Church and her role in the salvation history. May the Milagres Mother, patroness of our diocese, intercede for all of us to live a fervent Christian life, following her son Jesus Christ.

4 ADMISSION TO THE SEMINARY

5 VOCATION SUNDAY

Vocation Sunday is celebrated each year on the fourth Sunday of Easter, which falls on 7th May this year. In the message for this day, titled, “Led by the Spirit for Mission”, Pope Francis reflects on the missionary dimension of our Christian calling. The Holy Father says that “commitment to mission is not something added on to the Christian life as a kind of decoration, but is instead an essential element of faith itself.” “A relationship with the Lord,” he adds, “entails being sent out into the world as prophets of His word and witnesses of His love.” Even if at times when “we are conscious of our weaknesses and tempted to discouragement,” Pope Francis underlines, “we need to turn to God with confidence”, and he reiterates that by “virtue of baptism, every Christian is a ‘Christopher’, a bearer of Christ, to his brothers and sisters.”

6 WORLD DAY FOR SOCIAL COMMUNICATIONS

World Day for Social Communications is celebrated each year on the Sunday before Pentecost and this year it falls on 28 May 2017. This day was established by Pope Paul VI, after Vatican II, in order to draw attention to the “the vast and complex phenomenon of the modern means of social communication.” The Pontifical Council for Social Communications has chosen ‘**Fear not, for I am with you:**

communicating hope and trust in our time’ as the theme for the day. It is “an invitation to tell the history of the world and the stories of men and women. In accordance with the logic of the ‘good news’ that reminds us that God never ceases to be a Father in any situation or with regard to any man. Let us learn to communicate trust and hope for history.”

7. PRAYER FOR RAIN

We are all aware of the drought situation all over India. Lots of people are suffering due to the shortage of potable water. Only God is our hope who can send us rain. Therefore I request all of you to offer special prayers for sufficient rain. Please include a prayer for rain in the prayers of the faithful during mass on Sundays and also encourage the faithful to pray for this intention during their family and personal prayers.
