CATHOLIC EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY OF UDUPI

Dear Rev. Fathers,

I am happy to share the following information with you:

- 1. Good news from the PF department: According to an official communication received from the Ministry of Labour and Employment, the employers' contribution towards EPF will be paid by the Government of India for a period of three years (from 1-4-2018 to 31-3-2021). The employees/Institutions who fulfill the following conditions could avail this benefit:
 - a. The employee is registered under EPF after 1-5-2016. Those who are registered prior to this date are not eligible for this benefit.
 - b. The employee's gross salary should not exceed Rs. 15000 per month.
 - c.Only those employees who have joined the EPF for the first time are eligible for this benefit.
 - d. The Institution/individual which wants to take advantage of this benefit should be registered under PMRPY (Pradhan Manthri Rojgar Protsahan Yojane). I am told that this can be done on line within minutes provided you follow the procedure which is found in the internet (under EPF).
- 2. Withdrawl of Gazette Notification: I am happy to inform you that the Gazette Notification spelling out the Eligibility Criteria for Recognition as Minority Educational Institution issued by the Education Secretariat, Government of Karnataka on 19-3-2018 has been withdrawn thanks to the objections filed by the Christian leaders and Managements of Minority Institutions. Through this notification the Government of Karnataka wanted every educational institution wanting to be recognized as a Minority Institution to fulfill these two criteria namely, 1. At least two-thirds of the trust members should belong to the minority community and 2. At least 25 percent of the total number of students in the educational institution in an academic year should belong to the minority community. We were asked to file our objections if any, to this

proposal within 15 days from the date of publication of this Notification. Some of you too had filed your objections to this notification. Our hard work and concerted efforts have yielded encouraging results. Overwhelmed by the response of the Minority educational Institutions, the Cabinet instructed the Education Secretariat to withdraw the Notification forthwith. I thank you for joining in this campaign to save our Institutions from the clutches of the anti-minority forces.
