

Dear Rev. Fathers, Brothers and Sisters,

1. SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS

We celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus on Friday, **28 June**, this year. The solemnity provides us with an opportunity to awaken the devotion to the Sacred Heart among our faithful. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus today ranks among the most appealing devotions in the liturgy. Its widespread popularity among the faithful, as well as the transcendent dignity of its object, gives a place of high honor to this devotion among the numerous devotions which the Spirit of God has raised up and fostered in the Church. I exhort the parish priests to organize the devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, especially praying the Rosary of Divine Mercy, in the Month of June.

The Congregation for the Clergy has declared this day as the **World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests**. Let us remember to pray for all priests, specially, those serving in our Diocese, that they may experience the merciful love of Jesus through his Sacred Heart and impart the same to those entrusted to their pastoral care.

2. WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY

The Church celebrates **World Communications Day** each year on the Sunday before Pentecost. This year it falls on 02 June 2019. This year is the 53rd World Communications Day and the theme poposed by the Holy Father Francis is: "We are members one of another" (Eph.4:25)- from network community to human

communities. The theme underlines the importance of giving back to communication a broad perspective, based on the person, and emphasizes the value of interaction always understood as dialogue and an opportunity to meet with others. This calls for a reflection on the current state and nature of relationships on the Internet, starting from the idea of community as a network between people in their wholeness. Some of the prevailing trends of the so-called social networks ask us a fundamental question: to what extent can we speak of a real community in the face of the logic that characterizes some communities on social media? The metaphor of the web as a community of solidarity implies the construction of an "us", based on listening to the other, on dialogue and consequently on the responsible use of language. The CCBI Commission for the Laity has appealed to celebrate **Sunday**, 23 June 2019, as the Laity Sunday. St Thomas More is the Patron of the laity, whose feast is celebrated on 22 June this year. Let us affirm the role and mission of the laity in our local church and also encourage them to be active participants in the Church and society, and pray for their welfare. 5. NEW BISHOP OF BELGAUM

His Holiness Pope Francis has appointed Most Rev. Derek Fernandes (64), until now Bishop of Karwar, as the new Bishop of Belgaum on 1 May, 2019. Born on May 14, 1954 in Sirsi, he was ordained priest for the Diocese of Belgaum on May 5, 1979. He has a doctorate in Canon Law from Urbaniana University, Rome. He served as assistant parish priest and then promoted as parish priest of Holy Cross Church from 1979 to 83. He was parish priest of Immaculate Heart of Mary Church, Modage, from 1983 to 1986. He served as the chancellor and procurator of the diocese of Belgaum from 1991to 2002. He was the diocesan administrator of Belgaum from 2004 to 2006. He was elected Bishop of Karwar on February 24, 2007 and consecrated on April 20, 2007. An able administrator, Bishop Derek has exceptional communication skills. Apart from English, he speaks Konkani, Kannada, Hindi, Marathi, German, Italian and Tamil and is a proficient preacher with special concern for the poor and the marginalized. We congratulate Bishop Derek Fernandes on being appointed as Bishop of Belgaum, offer our heartiest felicitations and pray that God may shower his choicest blessings on him as he shepherds the Diocese of Belgaum.

6. BLESSING OF RENOVATED CHURCH AT THOTTAM

The renovated church of St Anne at Thottam was inaugurated and blessed by me on Tuesday, 28 May 2019, in the presence of the Parish Priest, Priests of Kallianpur and other Deaneries and the Parishioners.
